Existence and Uniqueness for Near-Horizon Geometries in the Cosmological Setting

Abstract: We prove existence and uniqueness results for all possible multi-axisymmetic near-horizon geometries with a given horizon topology in the presence of a positive cosmological constant. An explicit classification has previously been given in the $\Lambda = 0$ case, using different methods. Applications will also be discussed. This is joint work with H. Kunduri and A. Alaee.
